served as chaplain of the 80th Indiana Regiment, participating in the battles of Perryville, Resaca, and others

SAMUEL E. HOLTZMAN, of the class of 1861, a resident of Bloomington, was surgeon in the 58th Indiana Regiment and was with his regiment in the battles of Stone River, Chickamauga, Mission Ridge, and all the other battles of his regiment until the close of the war.

WILLIS C. HOWE, of the class of 1869, enlisted in Company F, 33d Indiana Regiment, re-enlisted as a veteran, and served until the close of the war, participating in all the battles in which his regiment engaged.

HENRY C. JERAULD, of the class of 1862, a native of Patoka, Ind., was a lieutenant of Company A, 80th Indiana Regiment. He saw action in the battle of Perryville.



JOHN C. McCLURKIN, of the class of 1872, enlisted as a member of Company F, 3d Indiana Regiment in 1861, and re-enlisted as a veteran in 1864. He served until the close of the war and participated in all the battles and campaigns of his Regiment.

ROBERT M. McMASTER, ex-'65, enlisted in Company F, 33d Indiana Infantry, in August, 1861, was made corporal of his company, and later promoted to lieutenant and regimental quartermaster. He re-enlisted and served with his regiment until the close of the war.

LYCURGUS C. MASON, ex-'68, enlisted as a private in Company F, 58th Indiana Infantry, in 1861, was promoted to sergeant and later to second lieutenant of his company. He was mustered out with his regiment at the close of the war.

ALEXANDER J. MONTGOMERY, of the class of 1869, was a lieutenant in the 80th Indiana Regiment. Among other engagements he served in the battles of Perryville and Resaca.

JAMES M. SCANTLIN, of the class of 1864, served as a private in Company G, 136th Indiana Regiment.

PLEASANT N. SPAIN, a student in the Preparatory School in 1859, enlisted in 1861 in Company C, 58th Indiana Infantry, and served three years with that regiment, being mustered out as first sergeant of his company.

GILBERT R. STORMONT, of the class of 1871, enlisted in Company B, 58th Indiana Volunteers, October 21, 1861. He was with his regiment in the Kentucky and Tennessee campaign, at Shiloh and the siege of Corinth, the battles of Perryville, Stone River, and Chickamauga, where he was wounded, and in all the battles
